Florida Archaeology Month: 3D Day at the City of St. Augustine Lab

The Northeast Regional Center partnered with the City of St. Augustine Archaeology Program to offer a special program on 3D digital heritage in celebration of Florida Archaeology Month. FPAN staff gave a brief talk and demonstration to 10 participants on 3D modeling in archaeology, including taking photos and printing models. Participants were then able to choose a model from a selection of artifacts modelled and printed from the City's collection to paint and take home. The program was a culmination of several years of partnership in digitizing materials from the City's collection to make them more accessible to the public in the form of 3D models.

Assisting Local Government: GPR Survey at 59 Weeden Street

The Northeast Regional Center assisted the City of St. Augustine Archaeology Program with investigations at 59 Weeden St. City staff invited FPAN to assist with locating what was believed to be an agricultural ditch through a GPR survey, hoping the results would help guide the placement of a mechanically stripped area. After uncovering an area suggested by the survey, City archaeologists believe they may have uncovered one of seven British period redoubts – the only of them ever physically located. FPAN staff assisted with some of the excavations and documentation of the resource.

Florida Archaeology Month: Cemeteries As Outdoor Museums at Sams House

The East Central Region Center continued their partnership with Sams House, the oldest standing home in Brevard County. Sams House is in Pine Island Conservation Area on Merritt Island. FPAN staff gave a talk to 50 participants with a follow up walk to Sams House mound, which is located on site and open to the public. This program set a base for future partnerships with St. Luke's Cemetery and started the process of getting their cemetery listed on the Florida Master Site File.

Assisting Local Government: St. Johns Resiliency Grant Site Monitoring

East Central Region Center partnered with the St. John's River Water Management District (SJRWMD) to monitor 6 archaeological sites in the Three Forks Conservation Area. All sites were remotely located and only accessible by airboat; Most sites on their priority list had not been monitored in decades. FPAN Staff mapped the shoreline for 1 site and submitted FMSF updates for six. This was a part of the ongoing St. Johns Resiliency Project.





Volunteer Opportunities: HMS Database Management Activities

Kassie worked closely with FPAN staff to complete site file updates for archaeological sites and cemeteries in the Northeast and East Central regions. Kassie and HMS Scout Chris Nolan worked together to complete new FMSF forms for over 40 cemeteries in Madison County. ---Along with other Northeast staff, she also continued to assist Rep. Glenda Simmons Jenkins of the Gullah/Geechee Nation in researching, locating, and recording on the FMSF cemeteries, archaeological sites, and structures culturally significant to the Gullah/Geechee Nation in Nassau County. Along with other FPAN staff, Kassie attended the FPAN-wide staff meeting over Zoom, where she and Rachael Kangas presented about the re-launch of the HMS program and went over how staff would interact with the new HMS Florida Scout Portal. Rachael and Kassie also discussed with staff some fundamental questions about the HMS program that needed to be answered for the re-launch to be completed. A paper that Kassie was third author on behind Emily Jane Murray and Sarah Miller entitled *Collaborative Science and Digital Tools:*

<u>Monitoring Heritage at Risk during the People of Guana Project</u> was published this quarter in the Journal of Field Archaeology.

Kassie worked on QRQC and updates for the HMS Florida Monitoring Database. She collaborated with Adam Cox at Legion GIS to fix bugs and glitches and complete updates to the Database. Kassie completed an FMSF update to the Database that added 51 archaeological sites and 41 cemeteries to the Database. After the official launch of the HMS Florida Scout Portal built in Canvas, Kassie continued to work with Rachael Kangas to fix any kinks and issues in the Portal and manage new Scout sign-ups as well as help volunteers navigate the portal. Rachael and Kassie also continued to create content to complete the Portal and re-launch of the HMS program. Part of this effort included redesigning the HMS Florida Monitoring Database website to make it match the new iteration of the HMS program which Adam Cox executed (see image caption for more information). Kassie continued work on the DHR Special Category Grant titled "St. Johns River Coastal Zone Survey and Resiliency Project" awarded to the FPAN Northeast Region. She worked with Northeast FPAN staff to create maps for permits for the project and seven permits were submitted to the state in this quarter. She also managed data created through monitoring visits. Kassie also worked to create documentation and spreadsheets of the work completed during the grant and submitted these for the second required quarterly grant report. She also completed work she committed to as the Database Manager of the National Estuarine Research Reserve (NERRs) System Science Collaborative grant project entitled "People of the Apalachicola System: Exploring Cultural Heritage as a Vector for Ecosystem Planning, Management, and Adaptation" lead by Nicole Grinnan, former Public Archaeology Coordinator for the Northwest Region. As Database Manager, she organized all data resulting from the project and created data packets for submittal to the NERR Science Collaborative and for public consumption (a redacted version removing sensitive information). As part of this, Kassie had to complete a Data Sharing Report that described all datasets created in detail including what types of data, file types and names, descriptions of the datasets, and where they were publicly available. The publicly available data were uploaded to an Open Science Framework (OSF) webpage that summarized the project, provided data and final report access, and linked to any relevant webpages or other relevant project information.



Kassie and Rachael redesigned the HMS Florida Monitoring Database website layout and design to make it match the new iteration of the HMS program. They sent their new layouts for the Homepage and "About the Database" pages to Adam Cox and he was able to update the website. Now the pages better reflect the program, incorporate the new HMS Florida Scout Portal, connect back to the other HMS websites, explain to new and existing Scouts what the re-launch means for them, and properly describes what the database is and how it's built and protected.
