Highlight of the Quarter: Archaeology Day at Brevard Museum of History and Natural Science

The 3rd annual Archaeology Day was held at the Brevard Museum on March 26th to celebrate Florida Archaeology Month. This is the third year of partnership with the Brevard Museum and the first with the Florida Historical Society Archaeology Institute (FHSAI) who recently took over management of the museum. The event offered free admission to the museum and eight hands-on educational activity stations that covered archaeology field methods, underwater archaeology, osteological analysis, historic cemetery preservation, prehistoric ceramics, and experimental archaeology.
